Responsibilities:

- Organize all new orders into the production schedule to make sure they start on time and that orders are prioritized appropriately to maximize productivity and on-time delivery.
- Work with Production Manager and other departments as needed to ensure execution of the production schedule.
- Oversee all floor associates in the fabrication department including 10-20 sewers.
- Enforce company policies and ensure associates are properly trained.
- Resolve or escalate material shortage issues.
- Ensure safe work practices are in use at all times.
- Ensure that all production activities are completed in accordance with design and process documentation.
- Ensure quality of products before packaging and shipping.
- Other responsibilities as assigned by management.

Required Skills:

- 6+ years of related fabrication experience with demonstrated leadership responsibilities required.
- High school diploma or equivalent; college degree a plus.
- Ability to work in a team environment and communicate effectively.

- Ability to prioritize, multi-task, manage time efficiently, and meet shifting deadlines
- Uncompromising attention to detail.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office.

Physical Requirements:
